ALLIED HEADQUARTERS IN NORTH AFRICA—(AP)—
British and Canadian troops, spearheading the first of several expected invasions of Hitler's Europe, won a foothold in Southern Italy today after a pre-dawn crossing from Sicily under cover of a terrific land, air and sea bombardment.
