## Germans Push 35 Miles Into Belgium

# PARIS—(AP)—Field Marshal Karl Von Rundstedt's armor and infantry had driven a 55 miles westward into Belgium to a point about fourteen miles south of the fortress of Liege up to noon Tuesday, it was disclosed at Supreme Headquarters today.
