

# Reds Still Holding Out

WASHINGTON, April 10.—The Russian delegation to the London Conference is still withholding agreement with Great Britain and the United States on whether a nation should be allowed to vote in the world security organization on disputes involving itself.

This problem, which was discussed today, may not be settled before the end of the deliberations between Russia, Britain and the United States on plans for an international agency to keep peace, and may have to be worked out by Messrs. Stalin, Roosevelt and Churchill themselves.

It is the one point, it was understood, on which the Russians have firmly refused a compromise agreement.

The issue is deeply significant, because it affects the very way of making the world organization to function in case one of the big four nations is an aggressor.

The agreed voting procedure on the council of the proposed agency is that the decision to use force against an aggressor must be made by at least a majority of the council, specifically including all the permanent "big power" members.

**COULD VOTE ACTION**

That under the agreed voting procedure any of these five countries—the U. S., Britain, Russia, China, and eventually, France—could effectively veto international action against itself.

However, there is an added provision, namely, participation of a nation in a vote on questions of voting itself. That is not agreeable to Russia, and the main reason for Russia's hesitation is believed to be the Russo-Polish dispute aggravated by the present Warsaw situation.

The Russians have shown considerable determination to veto their quarrel with the Poles without outside interference, retaining an offer of good offices from this country.

They also rejected it was learned, a British request to be permitted to vote on the Russo-Polish dispute and to be permitted to be the mediator in the dispute.

At a conference, the Poles, it is reported, have shown a desire to accept Russian mediation, and are reported to have offered to pay heavy losses on the return trip to England.

# Hurricane Alert Given

NEW ORLEANS, April 10.—The New Orleans Weather Bureau in its advisory at 4 A. M. (EWT) today gave a "hurricane alert" for the West Gulf Coast and advised small craft along the Texas and west Louisiana coast to remain in port.

The advisory said the area of "squally weather becoming more concentrated" was located 210 miles southeast of Brownsville, Tex., and moving slowly northwest.

Residents of Louisiana along the Texas coast were told they should be prepared to leave promptly for safer localities if warnings of high tides are issued.

The advisory issued at 4 A. M. (EWT) follows: Hurricane alert continues over the Texas coast. A large area of low pressure in the western Gulf of Mexico shows signs of further development with an area of squally weather becoming more concentrated, about a center located latitude 28° and longitude 94°. Indications are that movement will be slowly northward. Small craft on Texas and west Louisiana coast should remain in port. Residents of islands along the Texas coast should be prepared to leave promptly for safer localities, if warnings of high tides are issued. Hurricane warning was recorded still of "weak intensity."

The Miami Weather Bureau in its 4 A. M. (EWT) advisory said: "Tropical disturbance located near 17° North, 82° West, just south of Antigua, moving between West and Northwest, ten to twelve miles per hour, still of weak intensity. Continue precautions eastern Caribbean."
