

American amphibious troops invaded Iwo Jima on the road to Tokyo today, an Imperial communique broadcast by the Japanese radio reported.

Unconfirmed Dome News Agency dispatches, intercepted by the Federal Communications Commission, which said Yank assault forces had landed on two basches of the southern shore of Iwo within ten minutes, were followed by the Imperial announcement which claimed the attacks were repulsed and five attacking ships sunk.
