PARIS — (AP) — An intelligence officer of Supreme Headquarters who questioned Col. Gen. Gustav Jodl and other high therman officers said today that Nazi armies were under orders to invade Great Britain for three months after the fall of France.

The plans finally were canceled as too hazardaus.
