Between 450 And 500 B-29 Ships Attack

Fire Bombs Showered As Giant Planes Take Over Assault On Japan

GUAM — (AP) — Between 450 and 500 Superfort-resses in a pre-dawn attack today showered fire bombs on four Japanese cities over a 460-mile stretch.

The targets ranged from Oita on the northeast coast of kyushu to litratsuka, 34 miles southwest of Tokyo.
