Your injunction, sir, respectfully submit, deprives the miners of these Constitutional rights. As citizens the miners are entitled to the rights guaranteed in the Con-

stitution and the mine union leader declared last night that his contract with the Government, signed that day, settled all issues "for the period of the Government's emergency."
