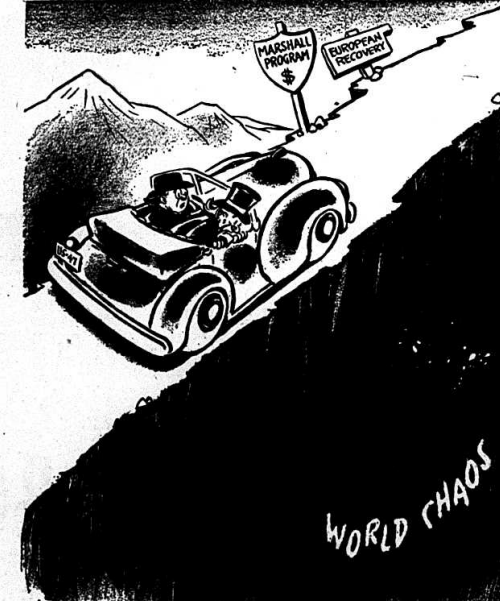
Camp Butner's Usage

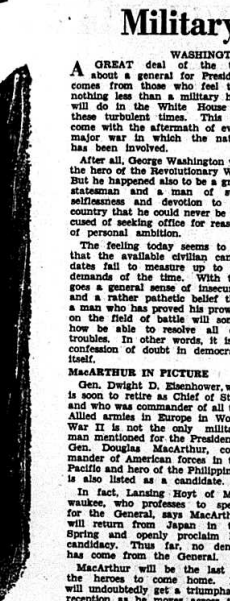
