Truman Scores Waste Of U. S. Natural Resources

EVERGLADES CITY, Fla. — (AP) — President Truman called today for constant vigilance in developing the nation's resources to prevent "raids" by "destructive influences" bent on exploiting "our common heritage for their private gain."

Without mentioning names, the Chief Executive declared: "The forests and our mineral resources, are subject to many destructive influences. We have to remain consistently vigilant to prevent such a waste of our national resources as not examples of enterprise and initiative. They are attempts to take from all the people for the benefit of the few."
