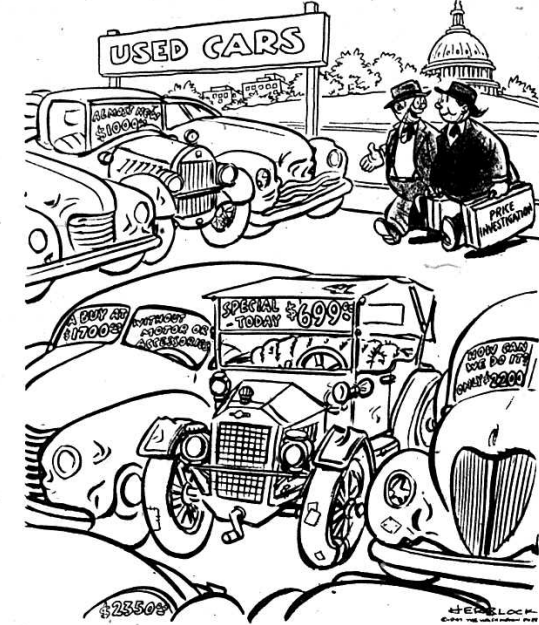

WARD ONE OF THE most revealing aspects of life in the Soviet Union are the jokes.
