By GEORGE W. CORNELL NEW YORK — (AP) — An East Coast longshoremen's strike evoked to full-scale proportions today, immobilizing a large part of the nation's ocean-borne commerce.

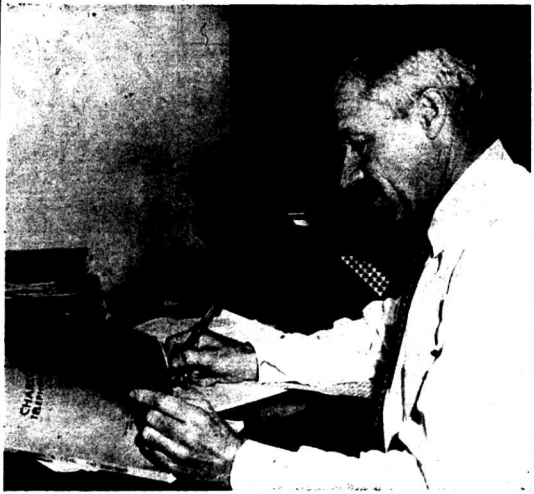
The official strike call was sent out by Joseph P. Ryan, secretary of the AFL International Longshoremen's Association, after he had convinced 11,000 members "overwhelmingly" to reject proposed wage terms.

The new embargo order by the Association affects the ports of Baltimore, Philadelphia, Hampton Roads, Va., and Wilmington, Del. Embargo on export freight through the ports of New York and Boston was ordered Tuesday.

Freight for export from the ports will be handled by the railroads unless the U. S. Armed forces and customs within set extensions and the embargo order.
