CHARLOTTE has a water problem that is stumping the City Council. The question is this:

Do the taxpayers want to save a few cents on the tax rate this year and take a chance on a costly water shortage next year? They will have to pay the increase next year in any event. All they stand to gain is a year's grace from a small increase in the levy. What they stand to lose is in-galiculable.

The problem has developed in this fashfon: During the war, Charlotte faced a serious water situation which prompted the
city to vote 31,800,000 in honds for expansion of our reservoir, filter station, pump
and pipeline facilities. Virtually all that
money has been spent and the project that

the inflation in prices for everything since
the work started.

A fund of 3800,000 is needed to finish the
Job. Council has provided for \$100,000 of
that amount in its new budget cailing for
a tax rate of \$13.22. Authorization of the
other \$100,000 has been delayed by objections to any further hike in the levy, even
a slight one.
