### Presbyterians Hear Request For Change

#### Minority Rights Would Be Allowed

**MONTREAT** — (AP) — Southern Presbyterians today were asked to support an amendment to the U. S. Constitution which would make this country a "Christian-Nation" officially.

The communication was one of half dozen resolutions submitted to the 9th General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the U. S. from the floor.

Included among the others was a request for the church to take a stand on conscientious objection to war. It is an unregarded matter, planned by the church and young people.

The proposed constitutional amendment contained in House Resolution 161 declares "this nation solemnly recognizes the authority and law of Jesus Christ, savior and ruler of nations."

Sections two and three of the resolution, said the recommendation, would require that all minority groups in the U. S. go to right about worshipping as they please.

**RESOLUTION PROBLEMATICAL**

Whether the resolution would be in effect until such time as the church declares freedom of religion and conscience, church and state, was highly problematical.

The recommendation was submitted by Dr. C. C. McKeith of Pittsburgh, chairman of the Christian American Movement. Headquarters for the movement are in Tampa, Fla.

In a letter to the Assembly which last night named W. E. Price, Layman of Charlotte, N. C., as moderator of the 9th General Assembly, said he had been advised of a plan to have a youth training school for white and Negro boys.

Before such a meeting is held, Clark wrote, he wanted approval by the Assembly.

The third communication was the one on conscientious objection.

After the day in session, 20 resolutions, or resolutions, will be dumped in the Assembly's lap for consideration by the committee.

The House of Representatives reports submitted. First of the reports is to create a civil rights commission to study the constitution and to make recommendations on abolishing and ten others modified.

The 9th General Assembly, meeting in Buffalo recently, issued another call for unity among all branches of the church.

Price said he would not vote on the unity issue when it came before the Assembly because of his position as moderator.

### West Drafts Plan For Germany

#### Would Unify Divided Nation

**PARIS** — (AP) — The Western powers have drafted a plan to unify East and West Germany, official sources close to the Big Four foreign ministers said today.

The source said the Western blueprint would be placed before the Russians "in a day or two."

It comes after the Soviet proposal to the foreign ministers' conference in the electric central hall to run the conquered country.

VALLAURIS, France — (AP) — Radiant Rita Hayworth of the movies became the princess bride of Aly Khan today in a ceremony performed by this town's Communist mayor. It was a town hall ceremony spangled with some of Hollywood's finest and the richest of the East.

The ceremony climaxed a ten-month courtship — some called it a road-show romance — for Rita, 31, and the 38-year-old heir to millions. She has been a Roman Catholic; he is a Moslem.

Cherished by 500 villagers, the couple drove slowly away in a gray Cadillac convertible. A reception line with lobsters and champagne awaited at the Chateau de L'Hortone — the prince's country home — he wanted to hold the wedding.

Rita, who will be Marguerite Casanova of France, wore a big picture hat of blue and a blue, French-fur-trimmed coat that came down to the knees of the lace that belted make her famous in the movies.

The Aly Khan, forsaking his sports plaids for the day, wore striped trousers, a double-breasted black jacket, white shirt and gray suit.

Mayor Paul Derigon wore a dark serge suit enlivened by the red of his campaign sign.

The simple civil ceremony — the couple answered "oui" to questions of matrimony — took minutes after the groom arrived. ### Magistrate Refuses To Return Red

#### Free To Continue Interrupted Trip

LONDON — (AP) — Britain refused today to send German Eiser back to the United States to serve out two prison sentences he drew during investigation of his Communist activities there.

Row Street Magistrate's Court refused the American demand that Eiser be extradited. That left Eiser — called America's No. 1 Communist agent — a congressional committee — free to go to the Soviet zone of Germany — particularly an area of the East.

The squat, mid-appearing little man who had walked into the international terminal, heard his judgment stolidly at first. He solemnly shook hands with the policemen who had guarded him. But when he was released and he was free, he smiled and he was a hubbub smile.

"I wasn't worried," he said. "I feel fine."

"I am going to Germany as quickly as possible. I am very glad to see the American demand that Eiser be extradited and I hope they will be defeated many times more."

Eiser has been offered a professorship in the University of Leipzig, East Germany, and he has presumably that in view.

After almost two hours of argument in Row Street Court — the only British court which can deal with the American demand — Eiser's lawyer Laurence James Esler, of the United States, failed to prove that the fugitive had been convicted of any crime. "The Court has said so far as they know British law on extradition provides for an appeal only in the case of a British citizen. Counsel for the U. S. Embassy has requested for a right of appeal to the British court."
