PAVING BOND ISSUE

In all fairness to everyone concerned, it ahould be pointed out that there is no blueprint, no priority list for spending the million doilars for street paving listed on tomorrow's bond ballot.

Charlotte has a tremendous backlog of paving which would cost many millions if every legitimate need were met. No paving was done during the war, and little has been done since.

The accumulated needs are of many

types. We have, for example, 450 miles of public streets in the city of Charlotte. Of this total, 75 miles are a part of the State happens system, and are under State maintenance. Of the remaining 375 miles, 200 miles, more than half, are without hard surface.

But in addition to the tremendous needs in the residential areas, there is a long list of special projects which have been under consideration for some years. So me of

them:

1. Widening Stonewall St. from S. Gra-ham St. to IndepEndence Bird, including an underpass under the Southern Railroad tracks.

2. Widening Hill and Vance Sta.

3. Widening 11th St. from Brevard to N. Graham, including a new overpass.

4. Construction of a Jink between Kings Drive and Independence Bivd.
