Wreckage Is Sighted On Mountain Canadian Craft Falls In France

GRENOBLE, France—(AP)—French mountain guides today located the shattered wreckage of the Canadian airliner which apparently dashed head-on into an Alpine cliff with 51 passengers—mostly Canadian Holy Year pilgrims—and crew of 10.

The first aid report indicated two of the crash victims were dead. The plane was seen falling from the sky in the early morning hours of the 13th. The plane crashed in a forest near a small town.
