SEOUL—(AP)—United Nations forces expanded their slim bridgehead north of the Chongchon River today as some Communists mysteriously withdrew on the northwest Korean warfront.

Two U. S. 24th Division regiments and the British Commonwealth Brigade moved about two and one-fourth miles after a heavy air bombing in the Pakchon area north-west of the bridgehead at Anju.

U. S. propeller-driven Mustang fighters roared speedier Russian-built jets in an 85-minute air battle—longest of the war—over Sinajuju just across the Yalu River from Manchuria.
