6. What is your name, age and address? A. Jatricia Ann Graham, age 23 of 166 Lyeas St., Paterson.

4. Whre did you reside on June 17, 1966?

A. A21 E. 18th St., Paterson.

(2. On what floor did you reside and where was the apartment in relation to the tavern that is on the 1st floor of the address?

A. And floor front apartment right over the tavern.

Grill on the early morning of June 17, 1966?

A. Yes.

Q. Mould you tell me in your own words what you recall in regards to that shooting giving me every detail that you recall?

recall? h. I was lying on the couch and I had dozed off when I was analyzed by bang. Right after that I heard two rere bangs. At this time I thought it might have been Jis. Cliver I walked to the front trying to close the door of the tavern. window of my apartment in the parlor and leeked down at the neen elem to see if it was light. If it was out I would have known that Jim would have closed up. Just as I was looking at the sign which was still lit leard a weman's voice say "On no." I ran around to my bedroom and locked out onto Lafayette Street side, I saw a white car parked away from the curb just about in front of the door leading to the second floor from the street to my spartment. I saw two colored men running to this car. One man got en the drivers side and the other man got in the passanger side and the car speed away. The tires screeched as the car pulled away. I looked at the back of the car because I wanted to try to see the license plate. I noticed that it was a white car and the tail lights were wider on the outside and tapered in toward the center of the car. I couldn't see the license plate number but I know the license plate had a dark background and the letters were gold or yellow. I then ran to my son's bedroom, put my raircoat over my pajamas and wearxant without stopping to pet on my shows, ran downstairs to the tavern. As I entered the side deer of the tavern I saw a fellow takenxidentifiedan named bello coming in the front door of the tavem from the wilth St. wine. I saw Willie Exrins hanging onto a pole in the center of the tavern and as a I walked towards him I tau Easel Tanis lying on the floor near the air conditioner. I screamed and turned to go upstairs to call the police lecause I didn't have any money with me. As I was leaving I noticed bello joing around the end of the bar behind it. I went upstairs on! dialed the operator and told her to send the police. I then went back downstairs, as I was comit; out the hallway door denotairs from my apartment I saw B\_11; coming down Lafavette St. toward the tavern from my Fight. I went into Hazel asked me to call her boyiriend Pob 1 Lot the floor. his maker from her and again ran upstairs to call bob mile I was there I quickly changed by clothes and came back to the tayers, at this time the police were shere. I saw willie Laring there was blood on his Forehead, I saw Fred Kacyath who were call Sedar Grove Bob, Bazel Tanizara still bying, on the floor and I-saw Jim Oliver laying on the Theor behind

A. continued ---- the bar. I was crying and an efficer ached in to go upstairs to my apartment. Then an officer came to my apartment and I made a sketch for min of the tail lights of the car that I had seen. He cent dewnstairs and a smert time later I went down stairs to the street. After a short time a white car fulled up to the corner, there was a police car in front of it and there was a police car behind it and there were two colored men in the car. An officer asked me to walk around the car and look at it. I did to and I was positive that that was the car I had seen pull away after the shots.

You say that after you heard the shots you walked to the front window to see if the neen sign was lit? and at that time you heard a woman's voice say 'Oh no' and then ran around to the window of your bedroom to look out on Lafayette St. How long would you say it took you to get from the front window to the window in your bedroom?

A. Just a few seconds.

Q. When you looked out the window you said you say a car parked away from the curb and saw two colered men running toward the car. Can you describe these two men?

A. I saw two men with sports jackets, they looked well dressed, I telieve one had a hat on. At that moment I felt something was wrong and I tried to get the license number as the car pulled away, I couldn't read the number but I did see a dark plate with a yellow or gold letter but I clearly remember those tail lights.

Q. You say that after seeing the car pull away you ranto your sen's bedroom, put your raincoat on and ran downstairs. How long would you say it took you to put on your raincoat and run downstairs?

A. I would say about a minute or so.

When the police returned the car to the scene with the two colored men in it did you observe these two colored men?
A. No, I was concentrating on the car to see it that was the car.

Q. When you saw these two men tunning toward the car immediately after the shooting did you see any weapons in their hands?

A. Not that I remember, I was concentrating on getting that license plate number.

Q. Did you see James Oliver lying on the floor behind the Lar after the police got there?
h. Yes.

G. Did you notice anything unusual behind the bar when you looked at Jim?

A. I saw that the cash register door was open and there was money on the floor under the register near Jia's body.
