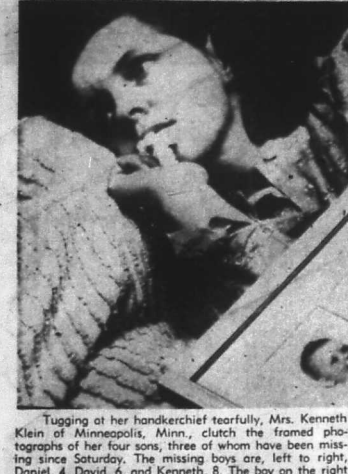


Onward Eisenhower
