Storm Gilda Centered East Of Charleston

 Tropical storm Gilda was centered about 500 miles east of Charleston late Wednesday night and was moving north-northwestward about 12 miles per hour. The outer northern edge will continue to influence coastal North Carolina weather through tonight.

Strong north to northeast winds are producing heavy surf and tides 1 to 3 feet above normal. There is also a risk of coastal flooding in susceptible areas during times of high tide, and of some beach erosion. Mostly clear skies are continuing over interior sections, because high pressure is the dominating influence. A weak cold front is expected to move into North Carolina from the west Friday. This front should produce some cloudiness but no rain. Everyone is urged by the North Carolina Forest Service to be careful with outside burning because of the continued dry weather. Temperatures were on the mild side again Wednesday. High readings were in the 70s, with a range from 70 degrees at Greensboro to 79 at Jacksonville.

UFO Spotted In Carolina

MOUNT AIRY, N.C. (AP)—A UFO was spotted in Surry County near Mount Airy Wednesday night. It was chased by sheriff's officers before it disappeared.

Sheriff James Taylor and deputies answered a UFO report. They were said to have spotted a red and white flashing object hovering over the Buck Shoals community off U. S. 52. A spokesman for the sheriff's department said Taylor and the deputies spotted the object at 9:30 p.m. and chased it until they lost sight of it. A long-time UFO investigator, George Fawcett of Mount Airy, was called to the scene and reportedly also saw the object.

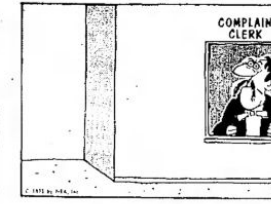

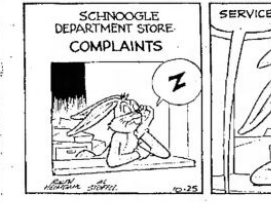
