SHAH'S TRY FOR POWER IS CRUSHED

Mossaddegh Rules Supreme Following Bloodless Revolt

By DON SCHWIND TEHRAN, Iran (AP) - Aged Premier Mohammad Mossaddegh has supreme power in Iran today after crushing a bloodless attempt to unseat him by supporters of Shah Mohammed Reza Pahlavi.

The young ruler and his beautiful Queen Soraya fled to neighboring Iraq Sunday night, screaming for an end to the monarchy.

Acting swiftly in the wake of the attempt against him early yesterday, Mossaddegh jailed top leaders of his opposition and dissolved the remainder of the Parliament. Though the 26-year-old monarch had not abdicated, the government was believed readying a regency council to take over his powers.

The leader of the coup attempt, Maj. Gen. Fazlollah Zahedi, hid in the house and a statement to newsmen he claimed the Shah had given him an imperial decree ousting Mossaddegh and proclaiming Zahedi Premier.

Police and troops, armed with rifles and stem guns, started a day of terror against the rebels. Tehran radio broadcast orders from Mossaddegh to customs and frontiersmen to prevent any escape abroad at any cost.

Tension lessened in Tehran today as truckloads of armed troops and Mossaddegh tanks called out by Mossaddegh rumbled back to their barracks and bases. Yesterday the city had bristled with troops protecting the government against their titular commander in chief, the Shah.

Along the capital's main streets today shop owners cleared away broken glass and smashed windows. Contractors who stoned the monarch's portraits in shop windows last Sunday were arrested.

The mob of Communist and Mossaddegh supporters—more than 100,000 strong—had headed toward the capital's main Parliament Square last night, howling for the ruler's blood. Shoppers demanded "Death to the Shah" and "End the dynasty."

The meeting handed assent to a demand for a regency by Foreign Minister Hossein Fazel, who was seized in the coup attempt. He was surrounded by guards and held for five hours in a palace storeroom. Fazel said in a newspaper article that he "robbed the property and chastity of the people."

There was no immediate statement from the Shah in Baghdad. He and his queen flew in his private plane from a Cantine Sea resort in north Iran where they had been vacationing. They arrived in the Iraq capital unharmed and were taken to seclusion in a government guest house.

New Quakes Hit Greek Isles

By ALLAN JACKS ARGOSTOLION, Greece (AP) - New waves including one rated as a strong earthquake struck the stricken Ionian Sea islands today as the three islanders estimated the toll from the week's devastation at some 600 dead and 700 seriously injured.

Fifteen new tremors were recorded during a 12-hour period last night and today. They heightened the toll from the week's devastation to more than 1,000 persons had been killed.

The new figures were based on complete reports from the island of Ithaca and nearly complete reports from the other two stricken islands, Zakynthos and Kefalonia.

Russian Bid For Conference

Reds Blamed For In Action On Germany

WASHINGTON (AP) - The State Department today accused Russia of delaying both a Big Four meeting and free elections throughout Germany.

The accusation came in a statement issued at a regular news conference by Press Officer Joseph Reap. It was the department's official comment on the Russian proposal for a peace conference with Germany.

The State Department had two main points to raise in regard to the Russian proposal. One particularly bad hole was reserved for prisoners the Reds had held.

Ike Calls For Greater Self-Help Effort By Allies

His report reviewed the mutual security program for the first time since the end of the Korean war. He said the program is "inextricably tied with the security and well-being of other nations."

Fellow Employee Points Finger At Hearing

WASHINGTON (AP) - A Government Printing Office employee identified a fellow worker, Edward Rothchild, face-to-face today as a nominee member of the Communist party.

James Phillips, a bookbinding machine operator, told Senate investigators that Rothchild has no direct access to secret material from the government printing plant but could easily get such material from other workers.

Phillips confronted the slightly built, pipe-smoking Rothchild at a hearing by the Senate Investigations Subcommittee, which is looking for evidence that secret material in the Government Printing Office has been leaked to the Communist Party.

Phillips testified he first met Rothchild in 1938. He identified Rothchild as one of 20 or 30 persons who attended a meeting in a private home to organize a Communist Party in the Government Printing Office.

Later, Phillips said, Rothchild and a Free Press approached him on the street and asked him in a "threatening and belligerent" attitude whether he was free or not. They offered him \$500 to organize such a cell.

Phillips said he thought it over and gave them their answer by going before the House Committee on Un-American Activities, headed by Rep. Dies (D-Tex.), and testifying about the whole affair.

Phillips also testified he once saw another fellow worker, Bertha L. L. L., in the Government Printing Office with secret material in her pocket.

Continued on Job The employee continued to work at the printing office for three months after she was caught, Phillips said.

Chairman McCarthy (R-Wis.) commented that the incident showed how easy it would be for a G.P.O. employee to come into possession of classified material.
