What's Your Problem

Fashion Expert Answers Question About Basic Color

Q—What would you suggest as my basic color and what exactly is meant by this term, basic color? My hair, which used to be quite blonde, has darkened. People still refer to me as a blonde but I think those days have gone forever. My eyes are green, complexion very light. I am 21, weigh 105 and am 5' 3 1/2" tall. And please tell me other colors good for me.

L.C.G.—The basic color is the one chosen for the main piece of the season's wardrobe, such as the coat, one suit, one or two dresses, skirt—and usually one complete set of accessories, or at least the leather case.

The basic color idea is a way to dress on little and is also a sound principle to follow, no matter how much money there is to spend. The basic color should be, first, becoming and correct for the wearer, and second, completely practical.

I believe navy is your best basic color, with black and gray as second choices. Begin with navy and let that be the backbone of your wardrobe. Other becoming colors to mix in are many tones of blues and greens with all the wonderful colors in between—such as aqua and turquoise, jade and peacock. You can also wear most pastels except yellow. Possibly a dash of true red. Be wary of yellow, oranges and all the warm colors down through flame, pimento and on to maroon and reddish browns. Avoid them. They are not for you.
