SPACE SHIP POSSIBILITY INVESTIGATED

Wilson Disclaims Knowledge, But Pentagon Tells Plan

WASHINGTON (AP)—Secretary of Defense Wilson has termed questions about space ships "a little dreamy" and disclaimed knowledge of such studies by the Pentagon, but his department said today it is actively exploring the possibility of creating artificial earth satellites.

And it has been going that for at least six years.

In response to a question about the status of a program mentioned in a 1948 report by the first secretary of defense, James Forrestal, the Defense Department today gave this official answer: "Studies relating to a satellite program as mentioned in 1948 are active and are being carried out at a rate commensurate with the technical state of the art."

"These studies are being coordinated within the office of the secretary of defense and provide for full utilization of the combined efforts of the services."

Wilson was asked at a news conference Nov. 16 if there was such a study under way. The exchange went this way: Wilson: "In the space ship business? Oh, no."

Q. Forrestal wrote about it. There was a study in 1948. Has it been discontinued or is it still under way? A. You are going back too far for me. I don't know of any such study.

Q. There have been recent published reports that the Russians have given priority to the establishment of the space satellite. Are you concerned that they will beat us in the air with it? A. I wouldn't care if they did.

Q. You really wouldn't? You mean you don't care if they get to the moon first? A. I would rather they go off to the moon or some other place than come over here.

Last week this reporter submitted the question—"Is the program still active?"—to the Defense Department. The formal reply was produced today.

In addition to the apparent limited circulation within the department of information about the satellite program, the project is under a "secret" classification.

So far as is known, the work is in the phase of laboratory and mathematical research. No hardware has been built to comprise a "space station" or an earth satellite.

What actual, proving-ground studies have been made are those resulting as a by-product of high altitude firing of rockets and guided missiles.

What the scientists aim at first is not the building of a "space ship" to carry men beyond the pull of the earth's gravity or to another planet, but an artificial satellite for scientific or even surveillance purposes.

There has been the suggestion of installing some form of automatic radar equipment on such a satellite to provide continuous surveillance of all nations of the Northern Hemisphere.

Prophet Calls Off U. S. Cataclysms

CHICAGO (AP)—A prophet of doom who had predicted cataclysms would engulf the continent before midnight said this morning there will be no disaster today.

Mrs. Dorothy Martin, who had predicted tidal waves would sweep over much of the land between the Arctic Circle and the Gulf of Mexico, said that by "intervention on the part of the God of earth, disaster has been stayed."

Mrs. Martin said she and 13 of her disciples, in her home in suburban Oak Park, "had sat for the father's message the night through and God has spoken."

"Not since the beginning of time upon this earth has there been such a force of good and light as now floods this room and that which has been loosed within this room now floods the entire earth," Mrs. Martin said in a statement.

Dr. Charles A. Laughhead, who lost his job on the student health staff of Michigan State College by acceptance of Mrs. Martin's prophecy, was among the 14 at her home.

Cold Catawba Dragged For Body Of Trainman

Police searched the frigid waters of Catawba River early this afternoon for the body of a South Carolina Railway bridge foreman, knocked from a trestle by a passenger train.

The foreman was listed as Lester W. Chapman, about 38, from Maiden.

Workmen repairing the trestle which spans Catawba River near the Wilkinson Blvd. highway bridge, said Mr. Chapman was struck shortly before 10:30 a.m.

They said he was standing on the north track of the double-track trestle when a passenger train, headed south, appeared. The workmen told county police that Mr. Chapman attempted to jump to the south track but was struck by the train engine.

His body was hauled over telephone lines beside the railway bridge and into the river's main channel.

Mecklenburg County Police, assembly officers and citizens of the nearby town of Belmont, were using grappling hooks in an attempt to locate the body.

Southern Railway officials said that the train which struck Mr. Chapman was Train No. 11, a passenger train bound from Durham.

French Debate Ratification Of Treaties

Assembly Disposes Of Committee Reports

By HARVEY HUBSON PARIS (AP)—The French National Assembly today disposed of final committee reports and got down to actual debate on ratification of the Paris treaties on German rearmament.

A parade of 40 listed speakers was led off by Gen. Pierre Aumeanier, a former De Gaulle. He opposed the treaties, saying they amounted to a way of preventing a break with the Western defense bloc at some future date.

Lobby talk persisted that a motion might be submitted to postpone debate. This could be introduced at any time. But there was no decision by sponsors of the move.

Should such a motion be forthcoming, it was expected to go down to defeat in the face of Premier Pierre Mendes-France's demand for assembly action before Christmas on the Paris treaties to enroll 500,000 West Germans as uniformed soldiers of the North Atlantic Alliance.

Similarly it was expected that the Assembly would vote finally, probably on Thursday, to ratify the four treaties. Political sources said some of Mendes-France's chief enemies want the Premier to be held responsible in the future for German rearmament, which those factions believe will prove a political liability.

The four treaties would (1) restore to West Germany almost all of the sovereignty the three Western Allies have exercised over their occupation zones since the end of World War II; (2) admit West Germany to a seven-nation Western European Union and permit the uniforming of 500,000 West Germans; (3) admit rearmament of Germany into the North Atlantic Alliance; and (4) put the rich disputed Saar Valley under the political control of the projected Western European Union.

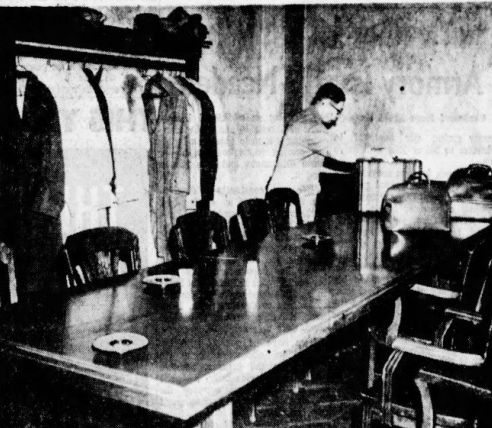

Park Board Outlines Stand On Rebuilding City Armory

The need for revenue was stressed today by the chairman of the Charlotte Park and Recreation Commission as a reason why the city's fire-damaged armory should be replaced.

The views of the commission were contained in a statement from Chairman Ernest J. Sifford written in response to an editorial in The Charlotte News.

"You have requested me to give you a written statement outlining the reasons why the Charlotte Park and Recreation Commission feels that it should replace the burned out armory with a new building. I feel that courtesy demands a reply, and at the same time, I feel that the general public is entitled to that information. Hitherto, our disquieted silence has signified the opinion we feel concerning some of the articles that have appeared in the press."

The Charlotte Park and Recreation Commission was given a job to do and was given a limited amount of money with which to do it. That job was to develop a system of parks and playgrounds which would furnish amusement and entertainment for all the citizens of Charlotte, both young and old, without regard to race, color or creed. Whether or not we have been successful, we are willing to leave up to the judgment of the people of this city. It has been a pleasure to me to plan something and then to create it is one of the greatest of joys—a dream come true.

This task has not been an easy one, for we have been constantly aware of the intrusion of the money factor. We spend a dollar here and save a dollar there. It is incumbent upon us to earn a large part of our operating ex-

penditures to supplement that given us from taxes and ABC funds. This year our operating budget before the armory fire was \$474,978.96. Anticipated revenues from the armory tax levy was \$209,968.00, from the ABC fund \$30,780.00, making a total of \$300,748.00. That left a balance of \$174,230.96, which we had anticipated earning. Since the fire, the above budget has been reduced \$40,000.00. In addition to our own budget, we are directed to give \$5,000.00 to the Mint Museum, an independent and unrelated organization.

"To accomplish our objectives, it has been necessary for us to practice severe economies. We do this by bargaining closely and keeping our salaries down. All

of our employees from the top down draw less money than similar city jobs pay, and they do not benefit by city pay raises. When it comes to the question of Community Center Directors, the turnover in that department is immense, simply because we haven't the money to pay them the salaries they should be getting.
