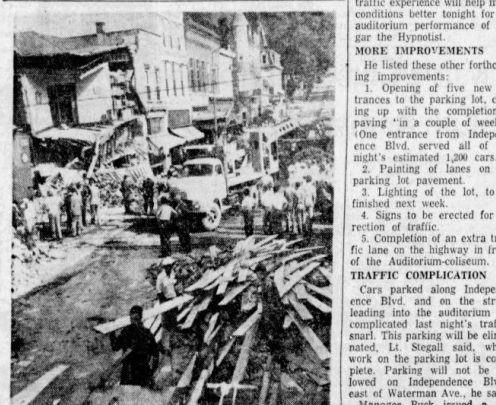




Eight Shot And One Reported Killed In Strike Disorder At Indiana Plant
