Eugene Du Pont, Retired Executive

WILMINGTON, Del. — Eugene E. du Pont, 84, a great-grandson of the founder of E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Co., died Friday at "Dogwood," his home near here.

Du Pont was a member of the board of the firm for nearly half a century before retiring in February 1963. He served first on the board of the Du Pont Powder Co., then on the board of the present company following reorganization in 1953.

His years with the company, starting in 1903 in the sales department, spanned the firm's growth from explosives production, its sole activity for the first 100 years, through the program of diversification in 1953.


