Optimism Expressed By All

By MAX HARBELSON GENEVA — The heads of the Big Four governments journeyed toward Geneva today optimistic their historic summit talks would at least find methods and machinery to solve the major cold war problems.

This view was expressed specifically by President Eisenhower and Soviet Premier Bulganin on the eve of their departure for the parley, which begins Monday.

The talks are expected to last no longer than six days, although no firm agreement has been reached on an adjournment date.
