Ike Goes Golfing, **Invites De Gaulle**

India Pushes Road

NEW DELHI (AP) — India's government of Kashmir is giving top priority to road building in Ladakh, where Red China troops have made recent incursions. Work is starting at once on a 46-mile strategic road, the government said.

The President flew to Scotland, and another big welcome from the people for three days of rest and golf after a stremuous set of conferences in West Germany, Britanian, and France. The talks were a prelude to his coming exchange of visits with Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchev.

The President shot an 89, 13 over par. It was the first time he had seen the tough championship course laid out along the edge of the Scottish coast.

In his letter to De Gaulle, Eisenhower spoke of the "warmth of the welcome I have received in France, the hospitality you yourself have extended to me and my party."
