

New York Bans French Movie

Unless Kingsley International Pictures can get New York State's Board of Regents to reverse itself, the French movie version of "Lady Chatterley's Lover" isn't going to be seen in the area generally considered the world's theatrical center. The movie has been shown abroad, of course.

The board has banned it on the grounds that "the whole theme of the picture is immoral... a presentation of adultery as desirable, acceptable and a proper pattern of behavior." Thus the screen adaptation is receiving the same censorship treatment the story in novel form had to contend with decades ago.

It will be interesting to watch how other states will react to the possible celluloid presentation of "Lady Chatterley's Lover," which is judged from some "stills" sent to this office recently, certainly must have some unusually intimate scenes in its length. Headlines Make Films For Zanuck

HOLLYWOOD, Oct. 5.—Launching a new career as an independent producer, Darryl F. Zanuck is once again snatching his film subjects from the headlines.

His next three films: 1—"Island in the Sun," which deals with the hot topics of miscegenation and colonialism.

2—"Paris Affair," the story of Sgt. Matthew McKoon.

3—"I Married Joe Stalin," depicting the monstrous excesses of the late dictator as seen through the eyes of his two wives.

Zanuck discussed these and other subjects during a recent interview in his king-size office at a large desk, rising occasionally to pace into an adjacent room.

"I'm going right back to the field where I have had my biggest success," he remarked. "I've found that I have stayed close to controversy, I have had great luck."

"This date back to 'I Am a Fugitive from a Chain Gang' and comes up through the year with 'Grapes of Wrath,' 'Gentlemen's Agreement' and 'Pinky.' Even 'How Green Was My Valley' was a risk because it was a labor story."

BIGGEST RISK
"I think 'Grapes of Wrath' was my biggest risk since the same time when the 'Paris Affair' was really hot.

"All of these pictures have not only made all the way, they were the biggest moneymakers in the years they were released."

"The only time I stabbed my nose with 'Wilson.' The reason it lost money was that it cost too much. It ran four million. If it had cost 2½ million, it would have made a profit of a million dollars.
