the weight.

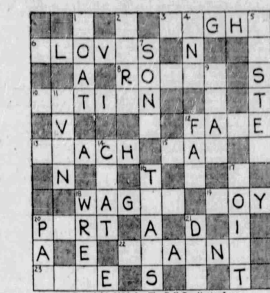
21. Dip is better than Dig. It is

Masic, 33, a farm worker; his  
wife, Wilma, 27; and their child,  
Zoltan, 2.

Their sponsor is Sanel DeBerry  
Bowles of 103 Canal St., Fayette-  
ville, N. C.

The Masic family is endorsed  
by the Lutheran Refugee Service  
and will enter this country under  
the Refugee Relief Act.
