Two Young Mitchell Women Die in Mishap

Two Mitchell young women were killed and two others hospitalized Sunday night when the convertible in which they were riding flipped over on Highway 37 a mile and a half north of here.

The vehicle skidded nearly 200 feet up the road before coming to a stop on an inside lane of the four-lane highway. Killed instantly were: Patricia Fay Corcoran, 21, Yvonne Adams, 19. Hospitalized in "very critical" condition was Mary Jean Schwartz, 22; Georgia Kay Cunningham, 21, was hospitalized in fair condition.

As investigating officers reconstructed the accident, which involved three automobiles, the 1955 convertible was traveling north on the inside lane. Near the intersection of the road on the north side of Lake Mitchell, the car clipped the right rear bumper and fender of another car which was about to make a left-hand turn. It caromed into the left side of a third car traveling in the right hand lane, went out of control and flipped upside down. Time of the accident was about 8:15 p.m.

SAIGON, South Viet Nam (AP) — Troops of the newly arrived U.S. 1st Division were attacked by the Viet Cong for the first time during the night and three Americans were killed, a U.S. spokesman announced.
