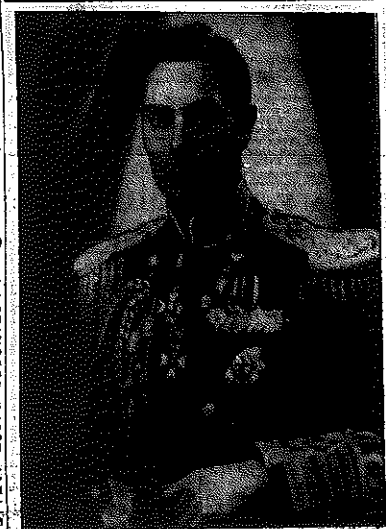

# State Leads In Security Applications

## 207,794 Old-Age Security Numbers Assigned Tar Heels, Federal Government Report Shows

Every seventh person in North Carolina and every fourth person in Charlotte has a federal old-age security number and for six weeks has been building up its security in Washington to take effect after he or she is 65 years of age, according to official figures released in Washington today and supplemented by local information.

North Carolina leads all the southern states in old-age security numbers. According to the Social Security Administration, the state has 207,794 numbers assigned, with Georgia second with 184,871, and Virginia third with 172,287. South Carolina, with 215,287, Arkansas with 123,200, and Mississippi with 106,800 are the lowest in the list and reflect significant deficiencies as being up to date in those states. The old age security law does not apply to agricultural workers.

Charlotte, as one of the southern spring centers, has sent in a large number of applications, but the figure is not indicative of the number of local applications, because as through Charlotte went all the applications of North and South Carolina outside of the first post office area. However, the Charlotte total does include the applications from the Charlotte community but they are not reported separately. Post office of Charlotte estimated that the total number is approximately 25,000.

# Coal Control Measure Valid, Reed Believes

## Solicitor General Goes Before Ways And Means Body To Give Opinion On Bill To Regulate Great Industry

Washington, Feb. 18. — Solicitor General Stanley Reed, home ways and means committee members said today, believes the Vinson coal control measure would stand the test of constitutionality.

Reed appeared before the committee to give his opinion on validity of the bill to regulate the nation's \$1,000,000,000 soft coal industry.

At almost the same hour, the United Mine Workers policy committee formulated the union's demands for a new law and hour agreement with soft coal mine operators.

Although the union leaders refused to make public exactly what they would ask, coal men expected they would demand a 30-hour week and a wage increase of at least 15 per cent.

The operators already have asked that the present 34-hour week be extended to 40 hours without any pay increase.

**COMMITTEE RECESSSES**

After hearing Reed, the congressional committee recessed without deciding whether to hold public hearings on the measure. Chairman Doughton, Democrat, North Carolina, said, however, the hearings probably would be ordered.

The Vinson measure, patterned closely after the invalidated Guffey coal mining law, does not contain the latter's (unconstitutionality) labor provisions, which were held unconstitutional by the supreme court, but would guarantee coal miners the right to bargain collectively. The guarantee would be buttressed by a provision requiring producers selling coal to the government to observe that provision.

**MEET WITH CASEY**

While this bill was under consideration behind closed doors, a group of coal operators met with Representative Casey, Democrat, Massachusetts, to discuss his bill to create a federal coal trade commission. A number of companies which fought the Guffey-Vinson measure last year were represented. Among them was the Carter Coal company which figured in the suit which resulted in supreme court invalidation of the original Guffey act—the only one of the various coal control measures to become law.

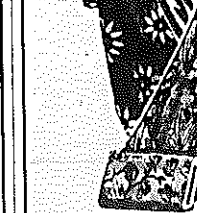

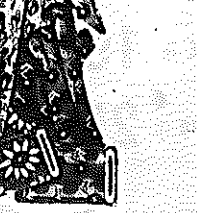
