Thus the second Japanese attempt to gain a Luco foothold within striking distance of the concentratio of military works around Manila supparently was smashed in a stubborn defense fight.

The Japanese first were reported landing at Lingayer last Wednesday. Within 24 hours the situation there was declared "under control," but it was disclosed yesterday that the Japanese were attempting once more to develop an attack there.

(A Tekyo official broadcast earlier told the Japanese people that their forces were advancing inland from the Luson landings and urging the Filipines to revolt.)
