## Troops Are Quartered At Armory

### Officials Keep Silent on Move

Unheralded arrival of a company of soldiers at 3 P. M. today to guard Charlotte's water and electric power sources made the war seem much nearer to this community today. They supposedly were ordered here from Fort Bragg. The first intimation of their duties came with their arrival and assignment to quarters in the Armory Auditorium.

Official explanation of their duties was not available. An Army captain had a conference of the City Hall this afternoon with City Manager B. W. Place, and Police Chief Harry Jones, after which all three declined to comment. Therefore, at this time it was known that the soldiers are here on active duty and were preparing to guard the community's essential services against such dangers as might threaten.

Meanwhile, excitement, rumor and defiance went about meeting the City against any possible acts of sabotage.

Detailed information from authoritative sources was severely restricted in being made. The stations of the Federal anti-sabotage act of 1917, which prohibits unauthorized disclosure of information in full effect upon civilians and members of the armed forces alike.

### CITIZENS ANGRY

The first shock and surprise of the wide-spread announcements of the Japanese attacks slowly were being overcome today by Charlotte citizens. Indignation and resentment against the latest aggression by the dictators was intense. Charlotte and hundreds of citizens expressed to newspapermen their utmost contempt for the treacherous double-dealing by Japanese emissaries at Washington to cloak the Japanese movement to warfare in the Pacific.

The precautionary activities of the military and civilian authorities here were started quickly and soon were in full effect.

All officers and men of the Charlotte Army Air Base were ordered to return immediately to their posts of duty.

War guards were placed by civilian law enforcement agencies over the city waterworks, the power producing plants of the Duke Power Co., the essential structure of railroads, and the vital points of communication.

Charlotte police were guarding the city's water facilities yesterday.

A conference of the police captain and the city manager was held today.
