3,000,000 Troops Expected To Take Part in Drive

By ASSOCIATED PRESS Adolf Hitler's invasion armies may expect a vast counter-offensive by 3,000,000 Red Army troops within two weeks, Soviet military quarters in London, predicted today, while the Germans declared that Nazi columns smashing toward Leningrad had destroyed seven Russian divisions (about 105,000 men).
